If we are reading a chapter of the Gospels, we might ask, “What did Jesus do, how did He do it, what does He say, what does He say to do?”</i></p>

7	<p><i>And forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us</i> 1/We read that we must forgive in order to be forgiven [Matthew 6:15-16]. 2/Father, please help us recognize any unforgiveness or sin in us [Psalm 139:23-24]. 3/Please help us confess our shortfalls to each other, and to pray to receive Your healing [James 5:16].</p> <p style="text-align: right;"> <i>Include\ Holy Spirit Confess it and let God address it Requests of 10 words or less Respond with Yes to His Behest</i> </p> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>At this time, we might admit our shortfalls, and formulate and/or share Requests to heal our shortfalls.</i></p> <p style="text-align: center;"> <i>1/As I read God’s Word, am I allowing the Holy Spirit to show me my Shortfalls? 2/When I recognize a Shortfall do I have another with whom to Co-Confess Shortfalls? 3/Am I careful not to let myself feel condemned when I find a Shortfall? 4/Do I remember that apart from God I can do nothing, but with Him all is possible? 5/With another, do I pray for God’s healings of my Shortfalls?</i> </p>
