	9/Am I aware that I am sitting with My Father? 10/Do I know, keep in mind, that He is fully attentive to me?
	11/Have I poured out what is on my heart to Him? 12/Have I poured out my "Needs and Bleeds?"
	13/Do I let Him pour Himself into me? 14/Do I listen to Him as I let Him pour Himself into me?
	15/Do I let my concerns and burdens become Requests? 16/Do I have full trust that He can answer my Requests? 17/Do I have full faith that He will answer my Requests? 18/Do I need to ask for help to trust Him and have faith in Him to do what is needed?
	19/Do I Respond to His Behest—His prompting? 20/Do I need to ask for help in Responding to His Behests?

9/Am I willing to let You guide me into Your Word? 10/Do I use the Word like a Mirror to show me my Shortfalls?

11/Am I allowing You, Holy Spirit, to reveal my Shortfalls? 12/Am I confessing my Shortfalls to another and praying for healing?

8/If I have a need to accomplish My Kingdom Mission, am I drafting a Request?

8/Am I responding with Yes at His Behest?

1/Thank You, Father, that You know what we need before we ask You [Matthew 6:8]. 2/Thank You for training us to ask, even though You already know what we need [James 4:2].

4/Have I submitted all Practicals for Your Gudiance?

5/Have I let my concerns and burdens become Requests of 10 words or less? 6/Am I trusting that God will answer the Requests? 7/Do I have faith that He can answer the Requests? 8/Am I ready to Respond with Yes to His Behest? And forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us 1/We read that we must forgive in order to be forgiven [Matthew 6:15-16]. 2/Father, please help us recognize any unforgiveness or sin in us [Psalm 139:23-24]. 3/Please help us confess our shortfalls to each other, and to pray to receive Your healing [James 5:16]. Include\d Holv Spirit Confess it and let God address it Requests of 10 words or less Respond with Yes to His Behest At this time, we might admit our shortfalls, and formulate and or share Requests to heal our shortfalls. 1/As I read God's Word, am I allowing the Holy Spirit to show me my Shortfalls? 2/When I recognize a Shortfall do I have another with whom to Co-Confess Shortfalls? 3/Am I careful not to let myself feel condemned when I find a Shortfall? 4/Do I remember that apart from God I can do nothing, but with Him all is possible? 5/With another, do I pray for God's healings of my Shortfalls?
