3	Genesis	1	2:25		<p>(Genesis 1 and 2, the full chapters, tell us what happened in the beginning, during the Creation of everything, when Jesus was the Word with God Our Father, when everything was made through Jesus.)</p>	
4	Luke	24	27		<p>Jesus in the Middle of God's Story</p> <p>27 And beginning with Moses and with all the prophets, He (Jesus) explained to them the things concerning Himself in all the Scriptures.</p> <p>(Of note—there are over 300 prophecies about Jesus in the Old Testament that are fulfilled in the New Testament. (See DDS—Jesus—Prophecies)</p>
