We might think of this as a puzzle.               <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. It can be helpful to think of this project as a hundred-piece jigsaw puzzle.</li> <li>b. Many of the pieces are ideas that need to be managed.</li> <li>c. Together we will find the corner pieces, then the edges, then the internal groupings.</li> <li>d. This process is incremental; it will take some time.</li> <li>e. We will need patience with the process and with each other.</li> <li>f. It may be helpful to think about absorbing what we can as we can.</li> </ol> </li> <li>3. Communications               <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. Because of the challenge in the process, we might keep communications in mind.</li> <li>b. Please speak up if you see an error or have a question.</li> <li>c. Honesty will keep us honest.</li> <li>d. Please beware of naysaying whispers, of going underground.</li> <li>e. We are seeking consensus and cooperation, not competition.</li> </ol> </li> <li>4. We may need to beware of infiltrations to distract our efforts.</li> <li>b. We encourage each person to seek his\her Goliath Stone (see below).</li> <li>c.
