

## DDS—Discipleship Path—Checklist (7)

The “Discipleship Path—Checklist” is a list of statements.

The statements are beliefs based on Scripture.

The beliefs are fundamental to a life in Christ, and to Following Him.

Scriptures are provided so that each passage may be reviewed and studied.

The statements can be used by an individual to assess his or her beliefs.

As we go through the list, we assess whether or not we believe the statement.

We can use the rightmost column to track our assessments.

“Y” is for Yes, “U” is for Unsure, and “N” is for no.

Agreement with each belief means that we are aligned with Scripture, and with fundamental beliefs of Following Jesus.

If we also allow the belief to become active in our lives, it will transform us.

For example, if we believe a good way to study Jesus is to regularly read the Gospel chapters, and if we do this, the Word, as we invite the Holy Spirit to work in us, will transform us.

Begin transformed by the Holy Spirit, as He uses the Word of God, we become True Disciples of Jesus.

The columns:

The number, the “#” column allows us to easily reference the statements.

The B column is the name of the Bible Book being referenced.

The C column is the number of the Chapter.

The first V column is the number of the first Verse of the passage.

The second V column is the number of the last Verse of the passage, if needed.

The “Statement,” of course, is the statement of the belief.

The “?” column is the tracking column, where an individual can assess his or her beliefs.

We invite you to use the following pages to assess your beliefs.

We encourage you to activate your aligned beliefs into True Discipleship.
